Education Benefits for Musicians

Your Tuition, Covered

The Ohio Army National Guard Scholarship Program covers up to 100% tuition to any state-supported school in Ohio, or the average of state tuition for a private university education.

Pay Off Student Loans

With the Student Loan Repayment Program you can receive up to \$50,000 to take care of any student loans held at enlistment.

Cash for Books, Housing, Food, and More

The Montgomery G.I. Bill provides up to \$13,200 cash to help with education expenses while attending college full- or part-time in monthly payments of up to \$367 for 36 months.
